

**Coproduction Office boards sales of Julian Rosefeldt's new film EUPHORIA, starring Giancarlo Esposito and with the voice of Cate Blanchett**

Coproduction Office has acquired international sales rights for EUPHORIA, the latest feature from filmmaker and contemporary artist Julian Rosefeldt, and will present the film to buyers at EFM.

Inspired by a 24-channel film installation, with the thoughts and musings of more than 100 economists, business magnates, writers and celebrities, EUPHORIA is a journey through the history of capitalism and greed. Populated by surreal characters and animals, a dystopian New York serves as the backdrop for a hypnotizing trip deep into the complexity of human nature at its best and worst.

A Berlin-based artist, Julian Rosefeldt is internationally renowned for his visually opulent and meticulously choreographed moving-image artworks, often presented as complex multi-screen installations – such as *Manifesto*, starring Cate Blanchett in 13 roles, whose film version premiered at Sundance in 2017 and was subsequently released in over 20 territories.

Based in Paris and Berlin, Coproduction Office is currently co-producing and handling international sales for Ruben Östlund's upcoming *The Entertainment System is Down*.
